George Herman "Babe" Ruth was born February 6, 1895 at 216 Emory Street, a Baltimore row house. The property was restored and the Birthplace opened to the public as a national shrine in 1974. Visit the museum which features exhibits on the life and times of Babe Ruth one of baseball's greatest players.
